Note: It is important to remember that many restrictions have changed since the canal began to face water level problems. Therefore, the waiting time reflected in our daily report is only a guide to how many ships/days are waiting to get a slot to transit with a reservation. This means there is a different waiting time than when ships wait days and are transited based on first come, first serve. There is no clear indication of whether the Panama Canal will return to transit non-booked vessels as in the past based on first come, first serve.
